# **Surrey County Council**

An update from our Surrey County Council representative Keith Witham.

As a member of the Surrey Police and Crime Panel, I get to meet and question our Police and Crime Commissioner regularly. One regular topic that residents raise with me is the effect of antisocial drivers who speed through our local areas.

So, I raised this with the Commissioner and asked what action Surrey Police take to deal with the issue, as enforcement of speed limits is a police responsibility. The response was encouraging. The Police have powers to issue warnings and seize vehicles in relation to the anti-social use of vehicles. A total 556 warnings were issued by Surrey Police last year and 32 vehicles were seized by the Force. It was confirmed that such warnings issued to drivers and subsequent vehicle seizures are a very useful tool in helping combat anti-social driving.

So as always, I would urge residents to always report incidents of excessive speeding or other antisocial driving to the Police. As much info as possible including a vehicle registration, time location etc, helps the police to build up an accurate picture of both locations and individuals.

I'm also due to meet with the Chief Constable, who is responsible for the day-to-day operations of Surrey Police, so if any residents have issues, they would like me to be aware of, do please email me: keithwitham1@hotmail.co,
