An update from Mike Price, Parish Councillor representing Jacobs Well.

Co- option of Councillor for the Ward of Jacobs Well

The Council is delighted to welcome Cllr Jonathon Snowball to the Council. Jonathon's contact details can be found on the Parish Council's website.

Public Consultation Jacobs Well Recreation Ground

The results of the Consultation document were as follows;

57% voted in favour for the provision of 4 permanent parking spaces in the Recreation Ground.

53% voted against the relocation of the goal posts.

53% voted for the removal of the duck feeding sign.

As a result of these votes the Parish Council will shortly be applying for S38 consent to create four car parking spaces in accordance with the Commons Act 2006. The duck sign will shortly be removed, and the goal post left in their original position.

Public consultation - development of Stringers Common

To mitigate the potential transport impacts of the Weyside Urban Village development improvements to the junction of Moorfield Road and Woking Road are required. The improvements need to be carried out on land that forms part of Stringer's Common which is designated as common land. The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has to give consent, under section 16 of the Commons Act 2006, to allow common land to be used for the improvements.

The Public Consultation will take place at Jacobs Well Village Hall, Wednesday 7th December from 3pm to 7pm.
