A decision has been made by the Secretary of State for Transport for four lanes on both the A3 and M25 at junction 10 (in all directions) and improved continuation slip roads.

It will take Two years to build but should improve traffic flow, which in light of the additional 1700 homes planned at Wisley airfield looks to be a needed development.

Community SpeedWatch

Deployments continue to be undertaken on a regular basis and is proving to be effective in reducing the speed of traffic through the village. All training is now provided via online tutorials.

Co-option of new member to Worplesdon Parish Council

Mr Mike Price has applied to join the Council representing the Ward of Jacobs Well. Mike's application is being considered at the next Full Council meeting on 19 May 2022.

Tree works - fallen tree beside Dollies' Pond

The fallen tree has been chopped up and the trunk stacked up on site

Land drains - Jacobs Well Recreation Ground

Works have unfortunately been delayed due to the death of one of the contractors.

Vandalism - Multi-play unit - Jacobs Well Recreation Ground

The Replacement parts are still awaited and will be fitted as soon as they are received.

Installation of a short path Harry's Meadow (between Derek's bench and the watercourse)

For health and safety reasons Worplesdon Parish Council is considering installing a short stretch of rural footpath between Derek's commemorative bench and the watercourse (as this section of the meadow gets wet and slippery during the winter months). Anticipated cost £3,350.

Replacement wooden kissing gate into Harry's Meadow

Worplesdon Parish Council is aware that the kissing gate is reaching the end of its life expectancy and plans to replace this as soon as practicable.
