The charity supports families experiencing the very debilitating illness, postnatal depression and anxiety. This affects approximately 1 in 5 mothers and 1 in 10 fathers experience paternal depression after the birth of their baby.

Unfortunately, if it goes unsupported and untreated it can have a huge impact on family life and is still the leading cause of maternal death in the first year, due to suicide.

Guildford Borough Council

The latest update from Bob McShee our local Guildford Borough Councillor.

Guildford Borough Council's household support fund offers a one-off grant of up to £300 per household for those who are struggling to pay for food, fuel bills and other related essentials. The scheme only runs until September 30, or until all funds have been allocated. People can also apply on behalf of other households who are experiencing hardship. Surrey County Council is responsible for highway verge cutting and weed control, as well as on-street parking enforcement. Currently, Guildford Borough Council has undertaken these duties and we are disappointed that Surrey has taken this direction. Guildford Borough Council will continue to maintain the verges until the handover in April 2023.

On Sunday, the 25th of September the Borough Council will put pedestrians first for Car Free Day 2022. We will be transforming our town centre again for a day of celebrations and free family fun.

Surrey County Council

An update from our local Surrey County Councillor Keith Witham regarding Unauthorised Traveller Encampments (UTE's)

You may remember from last year, when I was asking for your support to be re-elected as your County Councillor, one of the issues I said I wanted to see action on was more to tackle Unauthorised Traveller Encampments (UTEs) - which have plagued our area for some years at multiple local locations. The areas affected have been Jacobs Well, Broad Street Common (several locations), Pitch Place, Worplesdon, the Wood Street Village Green as well as in Normandy and Pirbright. I have continued to press our MPs and the Police and Crime Commissioner to follow through on that.

I'm really pleased that new laws which came into effect at the end of June make Unauthorised Traveller Encampments a Criminal Offence, giving the police greater powers, and duty, to intervene, including fines and the ability to seize the vehicles. Any police response must of course be proportionate to the situation, but these extra powers will help. Guildford Police used the new powers for the first time a few weeks ago when there was a UTE at Stoke Park, Guildford.
