Updates from Guildford Borough Council (GBC)

- Thames Water intend to submit a Planning application by the end of 2021.
- Guildford Borough Council have submitted a planning application for the land around Burpham Court farm to be changed into a SANG (Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace)
- Thames Water are relocating the Guildford sewage treatment works to the northeast area of Slyfield industrial estate.
- You can give feedback on the plans between the 13th of September and the 15th of October 2021, and there will be in-person drop-in sessions as follows
